

Wirral Cycling Group

CONSTITUTION

NAME

1. The association shall be known as Wirral Cycling Group

OBJECTIVES

2. The objectives of the Association are to promote cycling within Wirral by the provision of organised cycle rides, to work for the improvement of facilities for cyclists, and to encourage cycling as a means of exercising for health and of supporting the environment

MEMBERSHIP

3. Membership is open to all adults interested in cycling. The annual subscription will be set by the management committee

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

4. The Association's affairs shall be directed by the committee, which will be appointed at the Annual General Meeting on a simple majority vote of members. The committee shall consist of Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and up to six other members. Nominations for membership of the committee may be made at the Annual General Meeting or notified to the Secretary in advance. The Committee may co-opt up to four other persons if additional assistance is required. Three committee members are required to form a quorum.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

5. An Annual General Meeting shall be held once in each calendar year and not more than sixteen months after the previous one. The secretary shall give all members twenty eight days' notice of the meeting.

SPECIAL MEETINGS

6. The Secretary or a minimum of twenty members may require a Special General Meeting to be convened. The Secretary must be notified in writing at least nine weeks before the date of the proposed meeting of the reasons for the meeting and the motions to be proposed.

FINANCE

7. The Association shall be run on a 'not for profit' basis. Written corroboration from any two of the Treasurer, Chair or Secretary shall be in place before making a cash or online payment. Current bank statements will be reviewed and counter approved by the Chair at routine committee meetings.

CHANGE IN CONSTITUTION

8. This constitution may only be changed by a two-thirds' majority of those present and voting on a motion to change it at a General Meeting.

TERMINATION

9. In the event that the Association becomes unviable then the remaining assets must be donated to a similar cycling organisation.
