## **Committee Meeting Minutes - 7pm Tuesday 10th June 2025**

## 1. Apologies

#### 2. Approval of Minutes of Last Meeting

The minutes of the last committee meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2025 were approved as an accurate record. Actions from the last meeting were discussed at the relevant agenda items.

## 3. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer presented bank statements and income / expenditure statements to 31st May. Income year to date is £945, Outgoings £1,066 – the large proportion of this was for the certified first aid course, which will not be repeated next year. Bank balance stands at just over £2,000. These were countersigned by the chair as an accurate record of the Group's current position.

#### 4. Ride Leader Feedback

There was discussion on three main points, namely maximum numbers on rides, classification of rides, and how to deal with riders who can't sustain the pace / distance of the described ride, showing respect to ride leaders and all riders on the ride.

It was felt that the ideal maximum number on a ride would be 12 riders, but realistically to meet demand this would require additional rides to be put on by either extra ride leaders or current leaders leading more frequently. Therefore it was agreed to set a maximum number of riders per ride at 16.

Ride descriptions should clearly state the distance, speed and climbing plus any other issues likely to be a concern. Members have a responsibility to study the description and make a realistic assessment of their capability to ride the distance and speed before joining the ride. Otherwise it is unfair on the leader and fellow riders. If a rider is hampering a ride we have a duty to ensure that they are safely escorted to a station or to the end of the ride as appropriate. This may require another responsible rider leader to leave the ride to escort.

Riders are to be reminded that the Ride Leader is that – the ride leader. Riders should show respect to the leader and only pass or leave the ride with their blessing. Also riders are to be reminded to be careful of the language / "banter" used to other riders in case offence is accidentally caused.

The main item was to resolve the unsafe conditions at North Road rail crossing. WBC agreed to repair the highway approaching the crossing and also liaise with Peel to ensure the track section is made safe. Councillor Bird will be kept informed of progress and feedback to the Chair.

We were also reminded to use the Wirral Council online reporting system for road issues
